Contribution to international capacity building

Japan International Cooperation Agency Cat-B Hydrographer Training Program

Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) has conducted an international training course in cooperation with JHOD since 1971 in order to improve capacity of hydrographer in developing countries. It has been recognized, internationally, as a Cat-B certificate for hydrographic surveying since 1988.

Mr. Kurita was an instructor for an on-board exercise of this program in 2015, after coming back from the Training Program.



Lectures for foreign students at the Japan Coast Guard Academy

The Japan Coast Guard Academy runs "The Maritime Safety and Security Policy Program", in cooperation with Nippon Foundation, JICA and National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies (GRIPS), that targets junior officers from Asian coast quard agencies.

<u>Dr. Ito</u> gives classes on Maritime Environmental Science to students in the program, making the most of international knowledge gained from the Nippon Foundation / GEBCO Training Program.

Work for International Hydrographic Bureau (IHB)

Dr. Kaneda works at the International Hydrographic Bureau (IHB) as Special Projects Officer, making use of international experience based on the Training Program. He is in charge of development and operation of IHO database, data compilation with GIS and coordination of the IHO-Nippon Foundation CHART Project conducted at the UKHO.



Work for the Secretariat of Headquarters for Ocean Policy, Cabinet Secretariat of Japanese Government

In order to promote comprehensive and integrated approach to the ocean issues, Japan established "Basic Plan on Ocean Policy" in 2008.

Mr. Morishita and Dr. Yoshida were engaged as Deputy Directors for Counselor in the Secretariat of Headquarters for Ocean Policy, utilizing necessary knowledge and experiences obtained in the Nippon Foundation / GEBCO Training Program.
